

## **Information for members interested in running for Board positions**

### **Positions open for election by delegates**

Election of the Officers of the Party in accordance with Articles 5.1 (iv) & 5.2(ii) of the MLP constitution:

(a) Election of the following officers will be held (two-year term): Treasurer, Vice-President, the Director of Membership, the Director of Organization, and the Director of Policy

(b) Election of the following officers will be held (for one-year term): the Director of Fundraising

Election of Associations' Executive are elected annually at the AGM

### **Campaigning in a virtual environment**

Typically, candidates for the board positions campaign by attending MLP events like Wonderful Wednesday, Regional Meetings, Policy Incubators, Leader's Dinner, etc. and by hospitality efforts at the AGM itself.

This year we will be holding Regional meetings via zoom conference room so any candidate who submits their "Notice of Intent" to the Executive Director will be notified of the Regional Meeting and given the link to attend. Candidates in attendance will be introduced and given an opportunity for a brief speech.

Registered Candidates will also be given access to Liberalist on a limited access basis – the same way contestants in a contested nomination are, to use the resource of Liberalist to campaign.

Additionally- once nominations close, we will hold a virtual town hall where each of the candidates will be given an opportunity to speak. All members will be able to view the speeches to become familiar with the candidates.

### **The election mechanics**

These elections, along with the Leadership vote and Association elections, will be held using an on-line voting service. Association positions that are not filled by this process can be filled at the Association AGMs held on Saturday morning.

Registered Delegates will be issued a log-in link – which will be sent to them via email.
